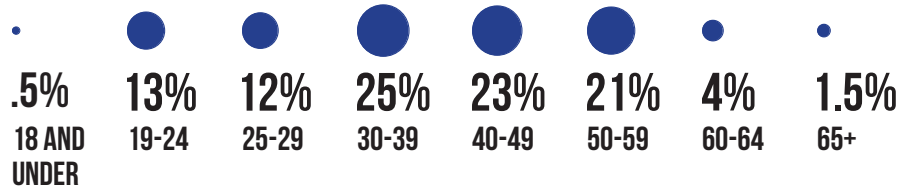

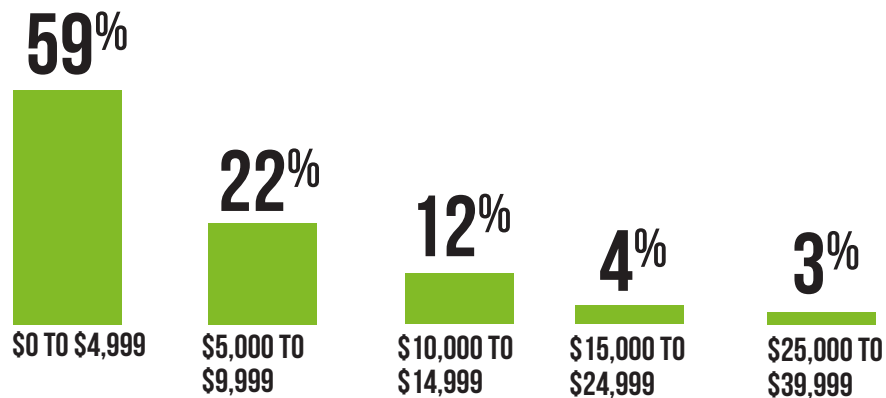



It's hard to imagine how someone can recover from mental illness and addiction without a home to call their own. Thanks to generous investors like you, housing is a building block of recovery for homeless veterans.

With your help there are options other than the streets. You are supporting essential Street Outreach, housing for the chronically homeless, housing and support for young adults 18–24, specialized housing for veterans and so much more.

With help from you and supportive landlords, we housed 373 people in apartments last year.



CenterPointe Crisis Response is a free, confidential resource that youth, families and adults can access any time day or night by calling the hotline. Walk-in assistance is also available at 1000 S. 13th Street during business hours.

In the last year, your partnership helped build a community-wide coalition that put suicide prevention signs in every parking garage in Lincoln and on the University of Nebraska Campus.



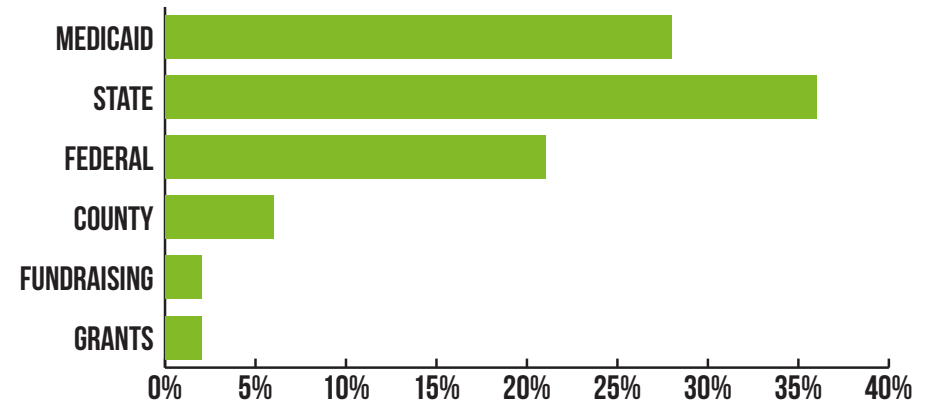

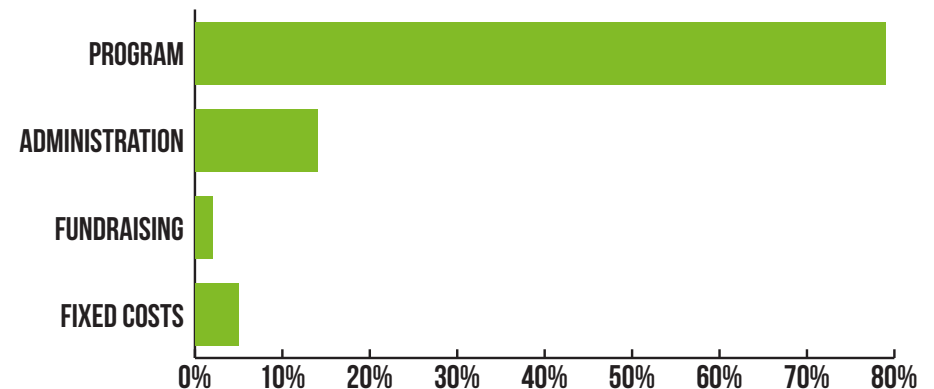
